उत्तराखण्ड कैम्पा की वर्ष 2019–20 की वार्षिक कार्ययोजना के भारत सरकार से प्राप्त अनुमोदन के संबंध में।

महोदया / महोदय,

दिनांक 05 फरवरी, 2019 को उत्तराखण्ड कैम्पा की संचालन समिति द्वारा संस्तुत वर्ष 2019–20 की वार्षिक कार्ययोजना को भारत सरकार के पत्रांक 11-100/2015-FC दिनांक 21/06/2019 द्वारा विभिन्न संशोधनों के साथ अनुमोदन प्रदान किया गया है। भारत सरकार के स्तर से प्राप्त अनुमोदन पत्र को उत्तराखण्ड कैम्पा की वेबसाइट (www.ukcampa.org.in) पर अपलोड किया गया है। आपसे अपेक्षा है कि उपरोक्त का अध्ययन कर तद्नुसार अनुपालन सुनिश्चित करेगे।

उक्तानुसार वर्ष 2019–20 की वार्षिक कार्ययोजना के भारत सरकार से प्राप्त अनुमोदन के मुख्य बिन्दु एतद्द्वारा उद्धृत किये जा रहे हैं:--

- The CA should be done as per the condition referred to state specific CA plan on CA site approved. The CA site of previous year CA done should be geo-referenced and uploaded in the e-green watch portal and the geo-referenced maps of the current year CA sites should be done as soon as the CA is undertaken this year.
- 2. The land based activity sites (Road side plantations, Gap filling plantations, Dwarfs species plantations and their maintenance included nursery raising, etc.) of previous years should be geo-referenced and uploaded in the e-green watch portal and the geo-referenced maps of the current year sites should be done as soon as these activities are undertaken this year.
- **3.** Purchase of fire arms is not permissible under the CAMPA rules and not allowed.
- 4. As per the CAMPA rules, expenditure on Forest Rest Houses is not allowed. Only construction of residences and office for field staff are permissible. The renovation/maintenance of only those existing buildings are allowed, which were constructed earlier from the CAMPA Fund.
- For the protection of bugyals (pasture land / meadows in high altitudes), a specific proposal may be prepared and approved by the State Forest Department before execution. The geo-referenced map of the proposed sites should be uploaded on e-green watch portal for record.

- 6. A long term management plan for the management of wildlife from CAMPA Fund should be prepared so that the duplicity of work in the National Parks undertaken from other fund of the State/NTCA etc. is avoided and the work are monitored by Monitoring Group. As per the explanation-2 to Rule 5 it has been provided that the mixing of the monies received towards net present value shall not be allowed with any other state schemes under implementation from any other budget either for capital or spill over works and the works undertaken under sub-rule (2) and sub-rule (3) shall be on standalone basis and there shall not be any duplication of permitted works under different components. Specific fund deposited by user agencies and deposited as IWMP component should be used as per the approval granted in the scheme.
- 7. Operational and contingency expenses cannot be met from the CAMPA fund.
- **8.** Preparation of working plans/Wildlife Management Plan cannot be done from the CAMPA fund.
- 9. It must be ensured that the fund for the management of State Authority such as payment of salary, etc. should be done only for the State CAMPA and not for other offices of the State Forest Dept. As per the CAF Rules the expenditure on office management and salary of officers and staffs of State Authorities should be done as per the Rule 6 (b) of CAF Rules 2018.
- **10.** For working with Van Panchayats a separate management plan for improvement of forest resources from NPV Component of CAMPA Fund should be prepared and submitted before execution of works.
- 11. Forest fire prevention, being an important activity should be done as per the National Action Plan on Forest Fire which was approved by the Ministry on April 2018 in consultation with State Government. The State Government should prepare a comprehensive State Action Plan on Forest Fire for the State in tune with the National Action Plan on Forest Fire and spend from NPV component.
- 12. All activities should be done as per the approved working plan of the State Forest Department and approved WLMP by the competent authority in the State and as provided in the rules, which should be prepared in consultation with the Gram Sabha as provided in the Forest Rights Act. The State Forest Dept. should ensure that no activity which is not permissible under CAMPA Act and rules and which are the prime functions of the State be carried out from the CAMPA Fund.
- **13.** As per the CAF Rule 2018 the APO should be prepared in consultation with the Gram Sabha as prescribed under the FRA before the APO is approved by the steering Committee of State Authority.

14. The State Authority should ensure that the expenditure from the State CAMPA Fund is done strictly according to the provisions of the CAF Act and CAF Rules and follow directions issued by any authority or court in this regard.

उपरोक्त विवरण सुलभ सन्दर्भ हेतु प्रेषित किया जा रहा है, कृपया उक्त का अनुपालन सुनिश्चित करने का कष्ट करें। उपरोक्त के कम में अवगत कराना है कि पूर्व में भारत सरकार द्वारा अपने पत्रांक 11–100/2015–FC (Vol III) दिनांक 05 अप्रैल 2019 से कैम्पा निधि के उपयोग संबंधी वर्तमान व्यवस्था को दिनांक 30 जून 2019 तक पूर्ववत अनुसार ही जारी रखने की अनुमित प्रदान की गई थी। इसी कम में भारत सरकार द्वारा अपने पत्रांक 11–100/2015–FC (Vol III) दिनांक 26 जून, 2019 द्वारा कैम्पा निधि के उपयोग की पूर्ववर्ती/वर्तमान व्यवस्था को दिनांक 30 सितम्बर, 2019 तक उन्हीं नियमों/शर्तों के अधीन विस्तारित किया गया है। उक्त गाइडलाइन को भी सुलभ संदर्भ हेतु उत्तराखण्ड कैम्पा की वेबसाइट पर अपलोड किया गया है।

उक्त के क्रम में कैम्पा कार्यों के क्रियान्वयन/निष्पादन में निम्न बिन्दुओं का विशेष ध्यान रखा जाये:--

• उक्तानुसार उत्तराखण्ड कैम्पा की वेबसाइट पर अपलोड की गई वर्ष 2019–20 की वार्षिक कार्ययोजना के संबंध में स्पष्ट किया जाना है कि यह कियान्वयन अभिकरणों के मार्ग–दर्शन हेतु अपलोड की गई है। इसे किसी भी प्रकार से स्वीकृति न माना जाये।

इसके आधार पर धनराशि की प्रत्याशा में कोई भी कार्य न संपादित किये जायें।

• कियान्वयन अभिकरणों द्वारा वे ही कार्य संपादित किये जायें जिनके लिये उन्हें कैम्पा निधि से धनराशि अवमुक्त की जायेगी।

धनराशि की प्रत्याशा में कोई कार्य संपादित कराए जाते हैं तो उसके भुगतान के लिये संबंधित अधिकारी
 स्वयं उत्तरदायी होंगे व ऐसी स्थिति में संबंधित के विरुद्ध नियमानुसार कार्यवाही की जायेगी।

Sub: Approval of Annual Plan of Operation (APO) of Uttrakhand for FY 2019-20

Kindly refer to the letter of the State CAMPA dated 2nd March, 2019 whereby the Annual Plan of Operation prepared as per the Compensatory Afforestation Act 2016 and Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules was submitted for approval of the National CAMPA.


The Executive Committee of the National CAMPA in its meeting held on 26.04.2019 has examined the APO of Uttrakhandand made following observations:

- 1. Rs. 45.00 Crore has been earmarked for Compensatory afforestation and maintenance of previous year plantations under CA. The CA should be done as per the conditions referred in state specific CA plan on CA site approved. The CA site of previous year CA done should be geo-referenced and uploaded in the e-green watch portal and the geo-referenced maps of the current year CA sites should be done as soon as the CA is undertaken this year.
- 2. Rs 8.0 Crore has been provided for road side plantations, Gap filling plantations, dwarfs species plantations and their maintenance included nursery raising, etc. These land based activity site of previous years should be geo-referenced and uploaded in the e-green watch portal and the geo-referenced maps of the current year sites should be done as soon as these activities are undertaken this year.
- 3. A provision of Rs.49.9 lakh has been made for purchase of fire arms. This is not permissible under the CAMPA rules and not allowed.
- 4. Provision for Rs.1.5 crore has been made for renovation of existing building and maintenance of forest rest houses. As per the CAMPA rules, only construction of residences and office for field staff are permissible and the existing building constructed under the various State schemes has to be done from the State budget and not from the CAMPA fund.
- 5. For the protection of bugyals (pasture land / meadows in high altitudes) a provision of Rs.4.00crore has been made. A specific proposal for this may be prepared and approved by

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- the State Forest Department before execution. The geo-referenced map of the proposed site should be uploaded on e-green watch portal for record.
- 6. **Rs.8.00** Crore has been provided for forest fire prevention and control operations. Forest fire prevention is an important activity but it should be done as per the National Action Plan on Forest Fire which was approved by the Ministry ion April 2018 in consultation with State Government. The State Government should prepare a comprehensive State Action Plan on Forest Fire for the State in tune with the National Action Plan on Forest Fire and spend from NPV component.
- 7. For the management of wildlife, Rs.19.88 crore has been provided from the NPV. For the purpose of high altitude and long distance patrolling, Rs. 1.00crore has been provided. Details have not been given. A long term management plan for the management of wildlife from CAMPA Fund should be prepared so that the duplicity of work in the National Parks undertaken from other fund of the State/NTCA etc. is avoided and the works are monitored by Monitoring Group. As per the explanation-2 to Rule 5 it has been provided that the mixing of the monies received towards net present value shall not be allowed with any other state schemes under implementation from any other budget either for capital or spill over works and the works undertaken under sub-rule (2) and sub-rule (3) shall be on standalone basis and there shall not be any duplication of permitted works under different components. Specific fund deposited by user agencies and deposited as IWMP component should be used as per the approval granted in the scheme.
- For the operational expenses and contingency at PCCF (HoFF) level, a provision of Rs.2.00 crore has been made. This cannot be spent from the CAMPA fund for being a non-permissible activity under the CAMPA Rules.
- For the revision of working plan and WLMP, provision of Rs.2.399 crore has been made.
 Preparation of working plans of State Forests and wildlife areas are State functions and cannot be done from the CAMPA fund.
- 10. For the support to Project Management Wing, Rs.1.00 lakh has been provided. As per the CAF Rules the expenditure on office management and salary of Officers and staffs of State Authorities should be done as per the Rule 6 (b) of CAF Rules 2018. It must be ensured that the fund for the management of State Authority such as payment of salary, etc. should be done only for the State CAMPA and not for other offices of the State Forest Dept.

- 11. For the purpose of forest fire prevention and strategic planning and strengthening of Van Panchayats, Rs.15.0crore has been provided. Vanpanchayats have been created by the State Government under UttranchalPanchayati Forest Rules, 2001 in the districts of Almora, Bageshwar, Champawat, Pithoragarh, Chamoli, Rudraprayag, Uttrakashi, TehriGarhwal, PauriGarhwal and Nainital Tehsil of district Nainital, Hill area of Dehradun Tehsil and Chakrata Tehsil of district Dehradhun and to such other areas as the State Government may from time to time notify. The NPV may be utilized for improvement of forest resource under their jurisdiction as per the provisions of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 to manage the Forest. Separate management plan for improvement of forest resource from NPV component of CAMPA Fund should be prepared and submitted before execution of works.
- 12. Forest fire prevention, being an important activity should be done as per the National Action Plan on Forest Fire which was approved by the Ministry ion April 2018 in consultation with State Government. The State Government should prepare a comprehensive State Action Plan on Forest Fire for the State in tune with the National Action Plan on Forest Fire and spend from NPV component.
- 13. Rs.36.22 crore has been provided for afforestation under Naomi Ganga Project from the NPV fund. State Forest Dept. should ensure that this expenditure is done strictly according to the approved plantation models in Naomi Ganga Project prepared FRI and approved by the Ministry of Water Resources. The plantation sites should be geo-referenced and uploaded on e-green watch portal and monitored separately.
- 14. Rs.10.0crore has been provided for the management of CAMPA office and to offset the incremental cost of CAs, etc. The details have not been provided. The State CAMPA must provide the details before execution.
- 15. All activities should be done as per the approved working plan of the State Forest Department and approved WLMP by the competent authority in the State and as provided in the rules, which should be prepared in consultation with the Gram Sabha as provided in the Forest Rights Act. The State Forest Dept. should ensure that no activity which is not permissible under CAMPA Act and rules and which are the prime functions of the State be carried out from the CAMPA fund.
- 16. The expenditure from the NPV should be as per the CAF Rules which provides 80% for core forestry activities and 20% for ancillary activities. The State Authority should re distribute



the permissible activities accordingly. Similar Rules applies for expenditure from Interest component.

- 17. As per the CAF Rule 2018 the APO should be prepared in consultation with the Gram Sabha as prescribed under the FRA before the APO is approved by the Steering Committee of State Authority. No such undertaking has been provided along with the APO, which may be provided.
- 18. The State Authority should ensure that the expenditure from State CAMPA Fund is done strictly according to the provisions of the CAF Act and CAF Rules and follow directions issued by any authority or Court in this regard.

The committee examined the proposal in light of the above restriction and approved the APO subject with the amendment for non-permissible activities referred above. The budget for the APO should be revised accordingly and informed to the National Authority.
